Re-Surfacing of Roads in North Lake

From S. G. Bengtson, Crew Foreman for the WC Road and Bridge Dept.

- 1) Williamson County is going to re-surface the streets in NL subdivision in the near future.
- 2) Some work has already begun such as crack sealing and level ups and base failures.
- 3) The clearance required for the equipment involved in the paving is 14 foot above the street.
- 4) Crews will be in the area in the near future and will trim foliage and limbs that are below the 14 foot clearance level.
- 5) The crews have had mandatory training in tree trimming and will use precautions to ensure quality work.
- 6) The cuts will be treated with tree trimming paint.

The re-surfacing will be oil and gravel just like we presently have. The budget does not allow for asphalt surfacing like is on Williams Drive.
